The event take place at Friday, June 11th, for ending of two years long project Power, which is dedicated to cyber violence prevention. The conference is meant for young people who are interested in cyber violence issues and who wants to enlist in non-profit sphere in the future. At the event will perform international and also czech personalities – e. g. Chou Yuhsuan, Catriona Graham, Bruna Diniz Franquera, Romeral Ortíz Quintilla or Pavel Houdek. There will be presented projects from Czech, Austrian and Romanian peer leaders, young people, who were firstly educating themselves for one year and then they lead their own topical edification projects. The whole conference is interleaved with postings by celebrities who are enlisting in feminism, cyber violence prevention or activism.

The purpose of this conference is to activate young people, who wants to dedicate on prevention of gender-based violence and set up their own initiatives. We will dedicate on how to establish own non-profit organization and how obtain its funding. The whole conference will take place in English language. Interpretation to Czech and Romanian language will be provided. Conference entry is for free.
